


## Organic Regulations


- Involve a set of production standards for growing, storage, processing, packaging and transportation.


About OFAJ	Objective of OFAJ




## Opportunities for Investors in Jharkhand

- The State has 10 lakh ha. Upland where minimum use of chemical inputs are prevalent. These upland is a paradise for future Organic Production.
- The State has abundant forest cover which abodes various Organic produce like medicinal plants, fruit plant, edible mushrooms etc. Specific natural produce identified and promoted for viable streamlined extraction.
- Traditional methods of crops production with minimum use of chemical inputs are common. Farmers are easily oriented towards organic production.
- The State has undisturbed eco-system, hence eco-friendly commodities can be promoted. The State receives high annual rainfall (1000-1300 mm per annum). The agro-climatic condition is conductive for commercial vegetable production. These natural resources are being tapped by establishing watersheds and organic villages.
